

Rules and regulations of the Bear Mountain Golf & Country Club

RCGA rules govern play except where modified by local rules.

"Out of Bounds" shall be defined by white stakes or white lines. Out of bounds is determined by the nearest inside points of the stakes or lines. A ball is out of bounds when all of it lies out of bounds.

"Lateral hazards" shall be defined by red stakes or red lines. "Water hazards shall be defined by yellow stakes or yellow lines. A ball is in the hazard when any part of it touches the stake or line. The stakes and lines are considered inside the hazard and may be removed if interfering with the execution of the shot.

"Water hazards" will be defined by yellow stakes or yellow lines. A ball is in a water hazard when it lies in or any part of touches the water hazard. Stakes and lines defining the hazards are considered in the hazard and may be removed if interfering in the execution of a shot.

Local Rules

Safety: Due to ongoing activity areas under construction will be deemed a "Developmental Hazard" (i.e. rock hazards, fescue, woodlands, etc.) If your ball comes to rest in this area, under penalty of one stroke, determine the point of entry and drop your ball allowing two club lengths from this point in any direction, but not nearer the hole. We request that you use extreme caution when entering these areas.

Embedded Ball: Through the green (except within a hazard), the ball may be dropped within one club length, under no penalty.

Drop Area at hole 2: when your ball fails to reach the green safely, under penalty of one stroke you have the option of using the drop zone to play your next shot. At holes 3 and 15: if your ball fails to find the fairway safely, under penalty of one stroke you have the option of using the drop zone to play your next shot.

All Poa Anna maintenance areas on the golf course are to be treated as Ground Under Repair.

Pace of Play

Please respect your fellow golfers and make every effort to maintain pace with the group in front. Bear Mountain's Player Assistants reserve the right to have you proceed forward a hole, or holes, if your group has not maintained pace. We strive to have golfers complete the course in 4 hours and 20 minutes in the a.m., and 4 hours and 45 minutes in the p.m.

Please utilize the divot mix located on every power cart, rake bunkers, and repair ball marks on all greens.
